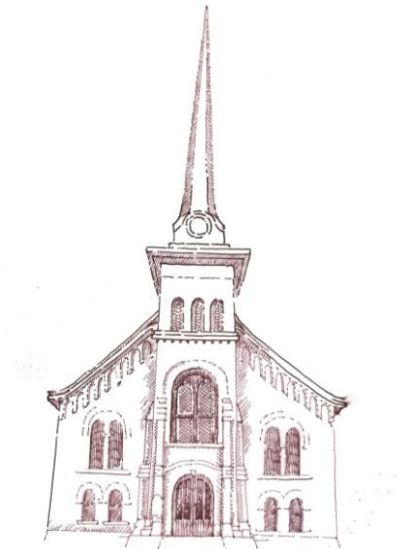

The **Jubilee House**, located just west of the church, provides housing for refugee families. Members of the congregation assist families who move into the house and help with upkeep.

Worship is central to the life of our church family. At United Church, we seek to provide diverse and enriching worship, relevant to contemporary life. Throughout the year, various models and worship experiences are offered for our spiritual enrichment.

Lively Learning for All Ages

Education provides opportunities to stretch your mind and fill your heart. Children's classes use storytelling, crafts, and drama to teach Bible stories and develop their faith. Youth contribute their energy to discussions about the Bible and faith relevant to their lives, and participate in mission projects and trips.

Adults can keep growing through thought-provoking weekly Bible study, the Adult Forum series designed to foster biblical and theological understanding, spiritual growth, and understanding of social justice issues. There is also a "Parents Place" fellowship and discussion group.

We are a gathering of people who believe God loves and accepts every person, and we, in turn, are called to demonstrate God's love in the world.
